**Abstract:** In "The Making of the New Deal," Katie Louchheim, who held several high-ranking positions in the Roosevelt Administration, gathers reminiscences from two dozen of its survivors, ranging from Lady Bird Johnson, who recalls her husband's role in the National Youth Administration, to Rep. Claude D. Pepper, who characterizes Eleanor Roosevelt as "almost literally the co-President in the sense that she had an active part in a perfectly proper way."
